## What To Bring

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- Small drawstring backpack (for water, snacks, etc)
- Helmet
- LED Headlamp
- Extra batteries (in ziplock bag!)
- Water Bottle, or Gatorade
- Individually wrapped snack bar
- Gloves (optional)
- Small Camera (optional- keep IN SEALED BAG)
- Trash bag (for your dirty clothes)
- Complete change of clothes
- Sneakers or hiking/work boots.
- flip-flops, or sandals
- Towel
- CASH for meals

## What To Wear In the Cave

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- tshirt that can be ruined with dirt/mud
- Jeans or shorts that can be ruined (jeans recommended)
- Sneakers or hiking/work boots. (NO OPEN-TOE SHOES!!)
- Helmet
- LED Headlamp

## What To Expect

We are going to have a blast at the Pettijohn's Cave just outside of Lafayette, GA. We will crawl in and spend around 3 or so hours underground together. Inside, you will have fun exploring the underground world. You will see stalactites and stalagmites. You will walk into giant rooms, and you will crawl through tiny crevices. We will see long, narrow hallways, strange mineral formations, and possibly get as far as the underground waterfall. All together, the cave extends for miles, and we will only get to see part of it. Are there bats? Yep.

What you wear in the cave will get MUDDY! Remember, a cave is a hole in the ground. You can walk in much of it, but lots of it is CRAWL-ONLY! Count on dragging yourself through mud for much of the day. It will ruin your clothes, and it is a LOT of work, but a lot of fun.
