Transportation

This is a family trip, and all families are kinda on their own for transportation. We're headed to Benton, TN, just north of Ocoee, up HWY 411. We will travel by bus from the outpost there to the put-in point at the river. The bus will also bring us back to the outpost.

Minimum Age: 12 years old

The Ocoee River is SERIOUS whitewater with a flow of 1200 cubic feet per second. The 12-year old minimum limit is Tennessee state law, and there are no exceptions.

What To Bring!

- Rafting Wear (see below)
- Complete change of clothes
- Shower Stuff (soap, shampoo, etc)
- Towel (for shower)
- Dry clothes to change into
- Individually wrapped snacks
- Lunch
- cash for dinner on return trip

Rafting Wear

Essential:

- tshirt
- swimsuit or shorts. NO COTTON
- Shoes or River Sandals (flip flops fall off! You need something that goes around your ankle)
- Sunscreen

Non-Essential:

- sunglasses (WITH retainer)
- Cap
